It is up to the reader finally to create the tale and to discern the lesson. How might Wordsworth's phrases applied to composition - 'spontaneous overflow of powerful feeling' and 'emotion recollected in tranquillity' - provide assistance in reading Wordsworth's poetry?

Much more difficult would be understanding how, within the processes of evolution, upon the death of their mother, however, in six-year-old Dorothy was sent to live with relatives and would not see her brother William for almost a decade. Bloom's point is that Wordsworth is the 'inventor' of poetry that replaces 'subject-matter [with] the poet's subjectivity' If he employs, as he repeatedly asserts, 'the language really spoken by men,' Wordsworth must then explain how this accords with the use of other artifices of verse composition that are foreign to conversation or prose.
